Terms & Conditions

The details terms and conditions for the said drawing competition are mentioned below.

1. Drawing Theme:

Three different themes are set for this competition, and the themes are divided into three categories considering the age of the participants. The details are as follows;

Category 1: Participants' age should be a maximum of up to 10 years*.

Drawing theme: "Draw as you like"

(*the maximum age of the candidate up to 10 years 11 months 29 days will be considered in Category 1)

Category 2: Participants' age should be in between 11 to 18 years**

Drawing theme: "Heroes in Red"

Description: Depict the selfless nature of blood donors and celebrate them as heroes

(**the maximum age of the candidate up to 18 years 11 months 29 days will be considered in Category 2)

Category 3: Participants' age should be 19 onwards***.

Drawing theme: "Give the Gift of Life"

Description: Illustrate the act of blood donation and the impact it has on saving lives

(***the maximum age of the candidate up to 25 years 11 months 29 days will be considered in Category 3)

The participants are requested to submit their drawings strictly in line with these themes and failing to do so; their candidature may not be considered. Ages will be considered as on 15th July 2023.

2. Age proof: The winning candidates will be asked to submit evidence of their age after the announcement of the results. The following documents may be considered as evidence of age.

- i. Copy of Birth certificate issued by hospital/Government authority
- ii. Copy of School leaving certificate/Madhyamik exam admit card
- iii. Copy of Voter ID/Aadhaar card/Passport

3. Drawing/Painting Rules:

- a. Entries must follow the competition theme.
- b. Only a single image a participant can submit. Submission of multiple numbers of images may cancel the candidature.
- c. A poster/drawing should be an individual effort of a kid/person.
- d. Acceptable tools for drawing/painting include pencil, crayon, watercolor, oil paint, etc. Photographs, wires, threads, digital art, and other 3D objects are not acceptable.

- e. The completed artwork must be on a flat piece of A4 size paper. Entries must be horizontal or vertical drawings/paintings.
- f. Words/slogans can be included in drawings/paintings.
- g. The drawing/painting must not represent any particular individual, organization, or brand name and must not depict any religious theme.
- h. The candidate's name should not be written on any part of the drawing.
- i. The image of the drawing taken by a camera must be submitted as it is. Editing of image color/contrast/hue *etc.* is not acceptable.
- j. It is recommended to record a video during the time of making the drawing. Winning candidates will be asked to submit the video before publishing the result.

4. Submission guideline:

- a. All entries must be submitted through the website www.jrcpaa.net only. Images sent by WhatsApp, e-mail, or through any other media will not be considered.
- b. Please fill in all the required detail before submission of the image. An incomplete submission may cancel the candidature.
- c. It is recommended to take the photo in an open light area to avoid any shadow effect.
- d. Children/persons with special needs may have assistance from their teachers, parents, or guardians to help with their entry. If assistance is given, please note this on the entry form during submission.

5. General Rules:

- a. Winning posters in original form (not a photocopy, reprint) must be submitted before the committee during the award ceremony (or when the winner will be requested to do so), failing which the award will be given to the next deserving candidate.
- b. The winning list will be published on www.jrcpaa.net and [JRCPAA YouTube channel](#) only. No individual message/mail will be sent to the participant. However, the committee will communicate with the winner through the e-mail/mobile number submitted during registration, before the prize distribution ceremony.
- c. The artwork must be the participant's original hand-drawn creation.
- d. The entry design may not be a copy or duplicate of any previously published art, including photographs or internet content. No copying or tracing will be accepted. Any mechanically or electronically generated artwork is not eligible and will be disqualified.
- e. Any candidate having a direct relationship with any executive committee members of JRCPAA can participate in this competition, but their entry will not be considered in the evaluation process for any kind of award. However, they will be facilitated with a participation certificate.
- f. A participation certificate will not be provided to any other candidate, except the candidate, mentioned in 5.e.

6. The JRCPAA Committee:

- a. is not responsible for loss or damage to entries;
- b. reserves the exclusive right to authorize the reproductions of all entries in any form, and to photograph the winning designs without compensation to entrants;

- c. has the right to use the winners' names for promotional purposes without compensation to entrants;
- d. will not return entries;
- e. has the right to take a final decision in case of any controversy arises.
- f. may ask for any additional information, if required.
